Arnold Christian Academy Open House

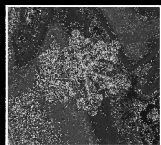

Mission Spotlight

Sisters in Service: Women and children around the world experience many hardships, and are abused, abandoned, abducted and enslaved. SIS tackles the hardest hitting issues that women and girls face by empowering them with educational programs, health and vocational training, micro-loans, discipleship, and rescue and restoration led by the local Christians in each country. Resist the Darkness is the SIS program that mobilizes people and provides practical interventions for girls who have been abandoned, abducted, and enslaved. Most of the 1,200 plus girls trafficked across the border of Nepal into India each year are under sixteen years old. In partnership with the Peace Rehabilitation Center, SIS works in Nepal to stop the exploitation of girls. Our front line effort is threefold: prevent girls from suffering the trauma of abuse through community education, rescue them from traffickers, and bring them to wholeness in a safe, loving home. During the upcoming year we will continue to raise money to open and support border rescue stations in Nepal and India. For more information, please contact Dawn Bernhardt at 410-439-0387.
